

Position: EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT RECOVERY COACH

Job Description: The Emergency Department Recovery Coach (EDRC) will, as an employee of Kingdom Recovery Center [KRC], provide direct services and support to those who have experienced an incident related to alcoholism/substance use and are being treated or have been treated at Northern Vermont Regional Hospital [NVRH]. This position reports to KRC and is Part Time and/or Per Diem. Part of each shift will also include time: interfacing with ED staff, patient families, performing follow up calls to recent patients, and staffing at the recovery center.

Reports to: RCED Supervisor Status: Part-time and Per Diem

Essential Job Responsibilities:

- Provide direct services to individuals receiving services in the emergency room following reversal from opioid overdose, or other alcohol and/or substance-related events.
- Provide education on overdose, and on obtaining Naloxone.
- Provide support and resource information to family members, as necessary and appropriate.
- Enhance opportunities for individuals to become familiar with Kingdom Recovery Center and other local community resources available.
- Assist individuals to identify and develop natural community supports in order to foster independence and community integration.
- Collect Data important to KRC and NVRH.
- Perform follow up calls to individuals who recently received RCEDP services.
- Promote Emergency Department program and other support services offered at Kingdom Recovery Center with local community partners.
- Maintain collaborative relationships with local treatment teams and in-patient treatment facilities in Vermont to assist clients with treatment needs.
- Model and exemplify recovery principles in order to show by example that recovery is
 possible and attainable, and utilize personal and professional experience to promote
 wellness and recovery.
- Abide by HIPAA, 42 CFR, and any additional regulations set forth by KRC and NVRH.

Required Experience:

- A self-identified person in recovery from alcoholism/substance use disorder, who meets the abstinence requirement of at least 2 years of continuous recovery [preferred 3 5 years], or who can otherwise demonstrate stability in their recovery, OR
- Experience with, or educational background of, recovery concepts and practices of recovery that honor any and all pathways to recovery.
- Organized, self-motivated, creative, and committed to working in a radically-inclusive environment.
- Excellent written and oral communication.
- Excellent interpersonal skills and comfort working with all levels of professionals.
- Experience providing both formal and informal presentations.
- Proficiency with Microsoft Office, Google Apps, as well as working with various data platforms.
- Valid Driver's License; reliable transportation and current insurance coverage.



Desired Skills and Experience:

- Preferred Recovery Center experience/affiliation.
- Trained Recovery Coach, or willingness/ability to attend upcoming Recovery Coach Academy.
- Understanding of the alcoholism/addiction treatment process, available treatment programs, healthcare options, social service systems and medical systems.
- Ability to work independently as well as part of a team.

Additional Requirements:

- Applicants may be required to submit a lab certified drug test, paid for by KRC
- Applicants must submit to a criminal background check, paid for by KRC,
- Employees will be required to attend various trainings, paid for by KRC
